- Item I give and bequeath to my Loving wife Elizabeth one third and the White Ward for her use and my Negro fellow Harry and the land of the plantation called the first lot during her natural life and after her decease I give the said Negro and plantation to my son Thomas
 - Item I give and bequeath to my son Thomas my little mare called Mania
 - Item I give and bequeath Two large powder Dishes a piece for a my Children and three Cattle a piece that is to say one Cow one Heifer & one Steer
 - Item I give forty head of Sheep to be divided amongst my Children
 - Item I give to my Loving wife twenty head of Sheep and two Cows
 - Item I give and bequeath to my son John my best bed & Holders & Cover and one Bed and furniture at the first lot
 - Item I give all the residue and remainder of my Estate of what nature or quality soever I give and bequeath as follows
 - Item I give to my son James my Bed that I lie on and the furniture belonging to it
 - Item I give to my loving wife my best bed and furniture belonging to it that lies up in the Chamber
 - Item I give to my Daughter Mary one bed and furniture that she lies on
 - Item I give all the residue and remainder of my Estate of what nature or quality soever I give and bequeath to all my Children to be Equally Divided according to the said thereof earnestly requesting my two friends Saml^r Davis and John Davis to see the same Equally Divided at my Decease and it is my will and Desire that each Childs part be Divided be and remain with my wife until the age of Twenty one or married and I do hereby nominate and Appoint my Loving wife Elizabeth and my son John my sole Exors^r of this my last will and Testament and Testimony whereof I have set my hand and seal this 14th of Feb^r. 1725/6
