In the name of God Amen. Know all Men by these presents that I John Penny of the aforesaid County being in perfect Memory & Remembrance but in low estate of Body do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner to follow following. First I Bequeath my Soul into the hands of Almighty God my Maker hoping through Jesus Christ my only Saviour & Redeemer free Pardon for all my Sins, And my Body to be buried in Christian like manner at the Discretion of my Executor hereafter nominated. Item the Use of my Land I bequeath to my dearly beloved Wife during her Life. Item after my Wifes decease my Land to be divided (Viz) that part of the Land whereon I now live joining to M^r Henry Pitt running to the deep Swamp and then to a Branch going by the Name of the little Swamp the little Swamp to be the Bounds the which Swamp runs through the Land and joins to the Land of M^r Thomas Applewhite this to be the one part, and all my Land the other side the little Swamp the other part. Item the aforesaid part whereon I now live I give to my Eldest Son John Penny. Item the other part I give to my youngest Son William Penny. Item I give unto my Son John One Cow & Calf. Item I give unto my Son William One Cow & Calf. Item The Use of of the remainder of my Estate I give unto my beloved Wife Mary Penny during her Life and after her Decease to be equally divided between my two Sons aforesaid mentioned. Item I leave my beloved Wif. Mary Penny my whole & sole Executor. In Witness whereof I have unto set my Hand the Day & Date above mentioned

At a Court held for Isle of Wight County Jan. 26. 1735.
