In the name of God Amen. I John Wright being very sick and Weak but in perfect Sense and Memory doth make this my last Will and Testament Renouncing all former Wills and Legacies afore made. I give and bequeath my Soul to God who gave it to me and my Body to the Earth to be decently buried as my Executors shall think fitt. I give and bequeath to my Son James Wright two Thousand Acres of Land whereon he now lives bounding on that side the Deep branch be the same more or less to him and his heirs for ever. I likewise give and bequeath to my Son James Wright five Shillings Curr^t money of Virginia. I give and bequeath to my Son John Wright three Thousand Acres of Land lying on the North side of the of the aforesaid Branch which is to say all my Land on that side of the Branch be the same more or less. I likewise give and bequeath to my Son John Wright all that tract of Land & Plantation whereon I now live all of both mentioned parcels to him & his heirs for ever. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Browne One feather bed and furniture & two Cows and four Sheep & 2 dishes 2 basins & 2 plates.

and for the Remainder of my Personal Estate whatsoever my Will and desire
is that it may be Equally Divided between my Wife and my son John
Wright and I hereunto Ordain and appoint my son John Wright and
my loving wife Martha Wright my whole and Sole Executors & Administrators
of this my last Will and Testament as Witness my hand and Seal this 16th
day of August 1738

Item I give to my Daughter Charity One Shilling
Now the rest of my Estate I freely give devise and dispose
Item I give and bequeath unto Mary Tily my Wife all my Land and all my
Moveable Estate goods and Chattels whatsoever during her life to her use
only to be enjoyed Item I give unto John Tily my son all my Land after the
Death of my wife his mother and my moveable Estate to be equally divided
between John Tily & Mary Tily my Daughter after the Decease of their
Mother whom I appoint my whole and Sole Execut. of this my last Will
& Testament Nov. 29. 1738
