 of the Shire of Wight County being sick and weak in body but of perfect me-
 mory and senses praised be God: I do hereby make and Ordain this my
 last Will and Testament in form following (viz) first I Comitt my
 Soul into the hands of Almighty God my maker & Creator hoping &
 assuredly believing through the merits and of Jesus Christ my Saviour
 to receive free pardon and Remission of all my sins and my body to the
 earth from whence it came to be decently buried at the discretion of my
 Executors hereafter named and as concerning all my worldly goods which it
 hath pleased God to endue me with I give and bequeath as follows to wit
 I give & bequeath unto my eldest Son Thomas Tarnal Two hundred
 & fifty Acres of Land to him and to his disposing for ever where he shall
 think good to my living Son William Tarnal One hundred & fifty Acres

I find lying and being over the second Swamp joining to Catherine's plot
 on the South side and down that land to Harpiss line to him and to his
 dequing for ever. I hereby give unto my loving daughter Elizabeth
 ten shillings and a barrel to her for fuel and one feather bed further
 more I hereby give my eldest son Thomas Varnal to see that I have
 done of Land lying on Swamp to be acknowledged to my son Joseph Var-
 nal then according to law: and as for all the rest of my Estate I give
 to my loving wife Elizabeth Varnal to my youngest son John Varnal &
 that he shall have during both to read & write to cast Accounts so far
 as the Rules of three kind if he dies without issue the Plantation to be
 to Thomas Varnal after the decease of his mother and Thomas Varnal
 where he now lives shall be to William Varnal to have and to hold for
 ever furthermore I have made and appointed my loving wife and
 loving son Thomas Varnal to be my Executors to see that my Will
 of fullfilled Witness our hand this tenth day of March in the year of
 our Lord seventeen hundred & thirty six
