And lastly I do hereby Nominate and Appoint my trusty & well beloved Friend Robert Carr my Son & sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament. And that after the Debts due from the Estate of my said Deceased Husband and from me be justly paid and the Legacies delivered, that y^e Estate then remaining of what Nature Quality or Condition soever it be that I am or ought to be possessed with be equally divided amongst my loving Children Henry, Lawrence, James, William, Mary, Sarah & Katherine revoking all former Wills by me made. I do Ordain this to be my last Will & Testament. And do Appoint my said Son Lawrence Baker to be Executor thereof.
