And all the rest of my Estate Goods & Chattels wth sever

4. I give unto my Son William Lucas and his heirs for ever
 to Appoint my Son William Lucas my whole & sole Executor to
 this my last Will & Testament revoking & making void all other
 Wills heretofore made by me In Witness whereof I have
 put my Hand & Seal this 31 day of December 1729
