In the name of God Amen I Nicholas Doring being weak of Body but of perfect mind and memory Do make this my last Will & Testament, as followeth Viz^t

I Give and Bequeath unto my son James Doring one large Bible one new Case of Knives & for his

I Give & Bequeath unto my son Meles Doring one of my best Beds & furniture
I Give & Bequeath unto my Beloved Daughter Susanah Doring one new quilted Hannah and all her increase to her and the Heirs of her Body Lawfully Begotten for ever but if she Dye without Heirs then this Hannah and her increase to return to my Son Meles Doring to him and his Heirs Lawfully Begotten. I likewise Give to my Daughter two Red Heifers, and their increase.

I Give & Bequeath unto my Beloved Wife Mary Doring all the Rest and remaining part of my Estate During the time of her Widowhood and after so return to my said three Children, James, Meles, and Susanah to be Equally Divided among them.

Lastly I Nominate and Ordain, my two sons James Doring & Meles Doring to be my Executors to see this my Last Will & Testament performed. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 2^d Day of July Anno Dom^o 1741.
