

In the Name of God Amen I Richard Jackson of Nettoway Parish in Isles of Wight County being sick & weak of Body but of perfect mind and memory am writing to settle things here I do make this my Last Will & Testament Committing my Soul to Almighty God. And my Body to the Earth and as for my worldly Estate which hereafter is expressed I Give Devise and Dispose of the same in the following manner & form.

Impr. I Give & Bequeath unto my Loving Wife Sarah Jackson the Plantation wherein I dwell & the Land thereto belonging being one Hundred Acres more or less During her natural life and then to be Equally Divided Between my three Daughters & my Gran Daughter that is Mary Jackson & Sarah Jackson & Nathrine Jackson & Gran-Daughter Ann Stuart to them and their Heirs & Assigns for Ever.

Item I Give & Bequeath unto my Loving Wife Sarah Jackson the Use of all my personal Estate During her life and then to be Equally Divided amongst my Children as aforesd. that is Mary Jackson, Sarah Jackson, Nathrine Jackson, and my Gran Daughter Ann Stuart. And I likewise constitute, my loving Wife Sarah Jackson to be my only & sole Exor of this my last Will and Testament revoking and Disannulling all and Every other former Wills by me before this time made Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have ^{unto} put my hand and Seal this 14th Day of October in the year of our Lord 1740.

In the name of God Amen Since the life of man is so uncertain I John Vaughan of Isle of Wight County of Virginia Do Constitute & Ordain this to be my Last Will & Testament making Null & Void all former Wills & Testaments which I have made First I Give my Soul to God of Heaven Depending on Christ my Saviour Dear to have Salvation thence my Body with the Earth from whence it came to be returned according to the Discretion of my Executors & as for those worldly Goods it hath pleased God to Bless me with I Bequeath as followeth

Item I Give unto my Wife Elvina Vaughan During her natural Life my Plantation my Negro Woman Dina and my Goods & Chattels in Virginia & Else where and after her Death I Dispose of them as followeth Viz

Item I Give my Plantation & all my Land of for my Wifes Death unto Vaughan Kilburn & his heirs for ever
Item I Give unto John Simons mine son of John Simons Junr of Long Bruns a Negro Woman named Dina after the Death of my Wife and of the said Vaughan Kilburn Dies without Issue I Give then I Give my Plantation & Land which I Give him unto John Simons mine in as full and ample manner as I have given
