- In the Name of God Amen I Robert Eley Son of the State of Wight
 County being in Reasonable health of Body & of good Sound & perfect Sense &
 memory blessed be God but calling to mind the uncertainty of this frail life
 and that it is appointed for all flesh to dye I therefore do make this my
 Last Will & Testament in manner and form following
- Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son Robert Eley one hundred Acres of Land more
 or less bounding on the Long Branch and so along John Roberts his Cart
 path that he leads to Cart Bar and so up Little Branch to a place called
 holly Service to Henry Sanders his line and so along that line and John Roberts
 his line to Mr John Sears line to a corner white oak in a little percomen
 and all the Land that I do possess down to the main Swamp to him and his
 heirs for ever
- Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son James Eley one hundred & fifty Acres of Land
 more or less beginning at the head of the Long Branch to the holly pond and so
 from the holly pond down the branch to a corner pine in John Roberts his
 line and so down the line to a corner Red oak and so along the line between Mr
 Jeremiah Coom and my self to a little Branch called the black piper branch
 and so up the said branch to John Roberts his Cart path to him and his heirs for
 ever
- Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Edward Eley Eighty Acres of Land more or
 less beginning at a corner tree that was formerly Samuel Watsons corner tree
 and so taking along that line to the main Swamp and so up the main Swamp
 to the foot of the branch called the pasture branch and so up the branch to the
 head line and so along the head line to Samuel Watsons corner tree to him and
 his heirs for ever
- Item I Give and bequeath unto my son John Eley Eighty Acres of Land more or less
 on the south side of the main Swamp along Samuel Watsons line to the
 Parkers line and so along Thos Parkers line to Mr Jeremiah Coom's line
 and from thence to the main Swamp to him & his heirs for ever
- Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Michael Eley the plantation whereon
 I now live with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging to him and his

heirs for ever only Reserving to my two Daughters Christian and Mary the privilege to live on the said plantation with their said husbands until Michael Eley should depart this life and least not before my Will and Desire is that my Son William Eley may have and enjoy this plantation and his heirs for ever —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Robert Eley one Negro Woman called Fanny to him and his heirs for ever and one long Gun called —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son James Eley one Negro Girl called Sarah born by his Natural Life and after his decease to his Daughter Martha and her heirs for ever —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Edward Eley one Negro Girl called Sade to him and his heirs for ever —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son John Eley one Negro Girl called Kate to him and his heirs for ever —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Eley Eley one Negro boy called Mingo to him and his heirs for ever —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son William Eley one Negro called Dacey to him and his heirs for ever —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Martha Williams one Negro Girl called Phillis to her & her heirs for ever —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Rebecca Williams one Negro man called Mingo to her & her heirs for ever —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Christian Eley one Negro Girl called Nancy and one feather bed and furniture which bed she usually sleeps on to her & her heirs for ever —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mourning Eley one Negro boy called Tom and one feather bed and furniture to her and her heirs for ever —

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son Michael Eley one Negro Woman called Hannah to him and his heirs for ever —

And my Will and Desire is that all the rest of my Estate which it hath pleased God to bless me with after my decease be equally divided amongst all my children before mentioned without coming to appraisement and I do by Brooke and Disannull and make void all former Wills and Testaments by me hitherto made or caused to be made and as herein this to be my last and Testament and no other, And I do constitute herein and appoint Robert Eley and Michael Eley to be my whole and sole Executors to this my last Will and Testament performed In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 5th Day of April 1750 and seven hundred and Thirty Eight —

Home First I Give to my Grand Daughter Mary Allen one pewter Dish one pewter plate likewise I Give to my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Allen one pewter Dish one pewter plate likewise I Give to my Daughter Sarah Hunter her choice of three of the Beds & the Furnitures belonging to and all the Feathers that is in the beds and be these of the Good ^{for} fill another bed and one bedtick to her liking or one new two shillings in money for to be paid by the Executor likewise I Give to my Daughter Sarah Hunter Twenty five weight of of pewter one Iron pot one Thimble & my own riding horse & saddle & bridle & young mare likewise to my Daughter Sarah Hunter three Cows & calves & 2 two year old Steers & a barren Cow for beef when my Daughter Sarah Hunter calls for it & the third part of my hogs as they are in hind & Chest & my trunk & two spinning wheels & two ps of Cards likewise I Give to my Daughter Mary Allen five shillings or the full value in thing likewise I Give to my Daughter Sarah Hunter one box Iron plates & Saw Tongs one brass Candlesticks one Iron Spitt one ps of Shaver one subboard half the Earthen ware to 12 Eggs half the Dung hill fories one Chains half the sider Casks half the water pails one meal tray one bag half my Books half my Spoons, to Six pewter plates more one warmer my pan half the bottles

Item I Give to my Son Joshua Hunter all the Rest of my Estate and I appoint my Son Joshua Hunter my hole Executor of this my Last will & Testament Resolving all former wills by me made as Witnesses my hand and seal this 23 day of August in year 1735. but if my Son Joshua Hunter or my Daughter Sarah Hunter should depart this life before they are married there part of my Estate that I have them Possession of other that is a live should oversett the whole Estate
