after mentioned and as for all my worldly goods and Land I give them as
followeth I give unto my Son John Coggan half my Land with my
Plantation I include in it being the uppermost part for the main swamp
I give it to him and the heirs of his body lawfully begotten for ever
I give unto my Son Robert Coggan the other half of my Land I give it to
him and the heirs of his body lawfully begotten for ever
I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Stevens one shilling no more
I give unto my daughter Ann Stevens one shilling no more
I give unto my daughter Sarah Coggan one feather bed one rug and
one blanket and one sheet and one pewter dish one basin two plates and six
spoons and one Iron pot and one cow and calf and one sow and pigs all to be
delivered to her at the age of Eighteen or married
I give unto my loving wife Sarah Coggan one feather bed the furni-
ture belonging to it and my will and desire is that she may have her
choice of my beds and one large chest and 4 pewter plates and two small
dishes and one flaggon and two cows & calves and two sows and pigs and one
Iron pot and hooks and one Wooden wheel
I give all the remainer part of my Estate after my just debts are paid
to be Equally divided between my two Sons John Coggan & Rob^t. Coggan and
I do constitute appoint and Ordain my loving wife Sarah Coggan my Son John
Coggan my whole and sole Ex^{rs} & Adm^{rs} of this my last will and testament
