 Negro Boy called Jammy one Chest and one feather Bed and
 Furniture which she has in her possession already to have
 her Heirs for Ever —

I give unto my son Jonathan Joyner three Hundred Acres of
 Land it being the Land where William Thomas did live
 and where Arthur Smith lives, and one Negro man called Dick
 One feather Bed and Furniture that is in his possession one Gun
 one Small Iron Pott and ^{his} Head of Cattle that he has in pos-
 session to him and his Heirs for Ever —

I give unto my son Matthew Joyner Two Negroes by Name Jack
 and Mingo and the plantation whereon I now live with Two
 Hundred & forty Acres of Land that unto belonging one pair
 of English hand millstones one Iron pott and one Gun to
 him and his Heirs for Ever —

I give unto my Daughter Patience Joyner one Negro Boy
 called Peter to her and her Heirs for Ever —

I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Joyner one Negro Girl
 called Phillis to her and her Heirs for Ever —

I give unto my son Thomas Joyner One Hundred and forty
 Acres of Land known by the Name of Village one Negro
 Boy called Joe one Still and Furniture one Gun that is
 called mine and one Iron pott to him & his Heirs for Ever

I give to my son Joel Joyner Two Negroes by Name Sarah and
 Sam one pair of hand stones, one Iron pott & one Gun
 One Iron spith and Seven Guineas to him and his Heirs
 for Ever —

I give unto my son Matthew Joyner the Use of one Negro Woman
 called —
