Will & Testament. Item. First to Principally about things

believing to receive full Pardon & Remission of all my sins through
my compassionate Redemeer Jesus Christ who gave himself to be
an Atonement for my Sins, and is able to save all that come unto
God by him seeing he liveth to make Intercession for them who comes
unto him for Mercy, in this Hope & Confidence I render up my
Soul with Comfort; next I give my Body to the Earth in full Assurance
of its Resurrection at the last Day, and as for what Worldly Estate
God hath bestowed upon me I give as followeth. First I desire
that all my just Debts should be paid by my Executor hereafter
mentioned. Item. I give to my Son William Powell of plantation
that he now live one and one Potts and one croft out door and
One Shilling in Money out of my Movable Estate and no more.
Item. I give to my son Joseph Powell all my Land at Corroough
joining to Robert Crans and one Gun, and one Gray Mare and
one Cow. Item. I give to my son Benjamin Powell the plantation
that I now live on after his Mothers decease and one Gun, and
one Cow & Calf and Hoifer. Item I give to my son in Law
Samuel Redebush one Shilling ^{in Money} out of my Movable Estate and
no more. Item. I give to my daughter Martha and herfor and
her Increase and One Shilling in Money out of my Movable Estate
and no more. Item I give to my daughter Rebecca Wilkinson
Five Shillings in Money out of my Movable Estate and no more. Item
I give to my daughter Mary Holland five Shillings in Money out of
my Movable Estate and no more. Item I give to my Daughter Elizabeth
Rachel Powell One Hoifer. Item I give to my Daughter Alice
Powell One Hoifer. Item I give to my Daughter Lydia Powell
one Pewter Dish and two Pewter Plates. The rest of my Movable
Estate I give to my loving Wife Mary Powell, but if she shall
happen to Marry, or Dye then that part of my Movable Estate
to be equally divided between her and the rest of my Children
except them debarred. I do Appoint my son William Powell
my trusty friend my whole Executor to see this my last Will
executed & performed Witness this Third day of October in the
Year of our Lord God, one thousand seven hundred and forty
four.
