 believing to receive full Pardon & Remission of all my sins through
 my compassionate Redemptor Jesus Christ who gave himself to be
 an Attonement for my Sins, and is able to save all that come unto
 God by him seeing he liveth to make Intercession for them who comes
 unto him for Mercy, in this Hope & Confidence I render up my
 Soul with Comfort, next I give my Body to the Earth in full Assurance
 of its Resurrection at the last Day, and as for what Worldly Estate
 God hath bestowed upon me I give as followeth. *First* I desire
 that all my just Debts should be paid by my Executor hereafter
 mentioned. *Item.* I give to my Son William Powell of plantation
 that he now live on and one Iron Pott and one cross cut saw and
 One Shilling in Money out of my Movable Estate and no more.
Item. I give to my Son Joseph Powell all my Land at Courrough
 joining to Robert Carrs and one Gun, and one Gray Mare and
 one Cow. *Item.* I Give to my Son Benjamin Powell the plantation
 that I now live on after his Mothers decease and one Gun, and
 one Cow & Calf and Hoifer. *Item* I give to my Son in Law
 Samuel Reddick one ^{in Money} Shilling out of my Movable Estate and
 no more. *Item.* I give to my daughter Martha no Hoifer and
 her Increase and One Shilling in Money out of my Movable Estate
 and no more. *Item* I Give to my daughter Rebecca Withinfor
 five Shillings in Money out of my Movable Estate and no more. *Item*
 I give to my daughter Mary Holland five Shillings in Money out of
 my Movable Estate and no more. *Item* I Give to my Daughter
 Rachael Powell One Hoifer. *Item* I Give to my Daughter Alice
 Powell One Hoifer. *Item* I give to my Daughter Lydia Powell
 one powder Dish and two powder plates. The rest of my Movable
 Estate I give to my loving Wife Mary Powell, but if she shall
 happen to Marry or Dy before that part of my Movable Estate
 to be equally divided between her and the rest of my Children
 except them beharred. I do Appoint my Son William Powell
 my trusty friend my whole Executor to see this my last Will
 Executed Performed Witness this Third day of October in the
 Year of our Lord God, one Thousand seven Hundred & thirty
 four.
