Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Son Thomas Crocker the Plantation I
now live on and all the Remaining part of my Estate

I do hereby ordain and appoint my Son Thomas Crocker whole
Executor of this my last Will and Testament revoking all and every
other by me formerly made and confirming this and no other to be
my last Will and Testament In Witnes whereof I have hereunto
set my Hand and this Twenty fourth of Septembere 1751
