I John Lee of the County of Isles of Wight Planter being of
Sound Mind, Memory & Understanding, do make & ordain this
to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form
following. *Imprimis*. My Will and desire is that
all my just Debts be fully Satisfied and paid; and that my
Body be decently Interred in the Bay Church Yard, accord-
ing to the discretion of my Executors hereafter named.

Item. I Give and Bequeath unto my two Children Thomas &
Jane Lee (to be equally divided between them) all my Estate
both Real and Personal to them and their Heirs for ever. To
be paid unto my Son Thomas at the Age of Twenty One
Years, and to my Daughter Jane at the Age of Eighteen Years
or Day of Marriage, but in Case either of them should
happen to die before they arriv at the Ages or day of
Marriage afores. then the Survivor shall enjoy the
whole. Hereby appointing Peter Furash, and Henry
Harrison my whole, and Sole Executors of this my last
Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other Wills by me
made, and this to be my only last Will & Testament. In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and
Seal this 9th day of January 1748.
