Item I Give unto my Loving Wife Susannah Rodway all the rest
of my whole Estate During her Natural Life or Widowhood
after my Debts and Funeral Charges Paid, Except either of my
two Daughters Mary or Susannah Rodway should Marry
before her Death then my Will and Desire is that they
have one Feather bed and Furniture apiece.

And after my said Wife's Decease I Give my Negro Boy Joe
unto my Daughter Mary Rodway only my Daughter
Mary to pay my Daughter Susannah Rodway Ten Pounds
if she Pleases otherwise my Daughter Susannah to have the
said Negro boy Joe and pay her said Sister Mary Ten Pounds
and ^{my} will and Desire, That after the Death of my said wife
that all the Remaining Part of my Estate be Equally divided
between my two Daughters Mary and Susannah
Rodway, and I do appoint my Loving Wife Susannah
Rodway my whole and Sole Executrix of this my Last Will
and Testament hereby Disannulling and Revoking all other
Wills before made as **Witness** my hand and Seal this Eleventh
Day of March 1750/1
