weak of Body but of perfect Mind and Memory Thanks-
be to almighty God for the same. I do make and
Ordain this my last Will and Testament in Form
and Manner following that is to say. I give my Soul
to almighty God who gave it me in full Peace and
Satisfaction

I have hereby bequeathed my Body to the Earth
to be buried in Christian Burial, according to the
Discretion of my Executors hereinafter named.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son John my Father
Bed and Furniture, both Curtains and Valances, Bolster
one Pair of Sheets one Rugg and Blanket, and one long
Table, and Three Leather Chairs, and one small Trunk
one great Chest, one Case of Bottles, one Stone Jugg, and
one small Pot, one great Dish, and one small.

Item I give to my Son William, one great Iron Pot, one Iron
Potsack, one Spitt, and Dripping Pan, one Stone Jugg.

Item I give unto my Granddaughter Penelope, one Father
Bed, Bolster, Rugg, and Pair of Sheets.

Item I give unto my Daughter Precilla, one great Trunk
and looking Glass, one Horse, Bridle, and Saddle.

Item I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth, one Bed, and Bolster
a Pair of Sheets, Rugg, and Blanket, and one Trundle
Bedstead.

Item I give unto my Grandson Robert Carr, Twenty Shilling
Cash.

Item I give unto my Daughter Margaret Daughtry five Shilling
Cash.

Item I give unto my Daughter Sarah More, one Gold Ring
and one silver Hood.

Item I give unto my Daughter Precilla, all the Hogs belonging
to me, and all my Corn, one Iron Pot, and Pot, Hook.

Item I give all the Remainder of my Estate, to my two Daughters
Elizabeth and Precilla, to be equally divided between them.

Item I give unto my Son John and William, my Linen
What, between them.

Item I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth, half my Cattle, and
the other half to be equally divided, between my two Sons,
John and William.

Item I give unto my two Daughters Elizabeth and Precilla
my Eggs of Shaces to be equally divided between them
