a Negro fellow called Jack to labour for her as long as she liveth
and after her Death to her Heirs of her Body for ever.
Item. I give and Bequeath to my loving Son Joshua Dawson
all the Cyter Casks that I have. Also I give Joshua Dawson
all my Wearing Coaths likewise a Barrell of Brandy.
Item. I give and Bequeath to my loving Son Henry Dawson
five Shillings Cash he having had his part before.
Item. I give and Bequeath to my loving Daughter Martha
Dinken five Shillings Cash she having had her part before.
Item. I give to my loving Son Joshua Dawson five Shillings
Cash he having had his part before.
Item. I give and Bequeath to my loving Daughter Sarah Inman
the half of my Share of the Corn & the Tobacco that is now growing
Item. I give and Bequeath to my House keeper Mary Cooks fifty
Shillings Cash if she liveth with me as long as I do live.
Item. I give and Bequeath to my loving Daughter Margaret
Warren my Riding Horse Bridle and Saddle. Also the half
of my Share of Corn and Tobacco that is now growing. Then
