make this my last Will and Testament, in Manner and Form
following (Viz.)

I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Sedin one Gold Ring
with a stone in it. and also one pair of Gold Sleeve Buttons to
be bought of my Estate by my Executor hereafter mentioned

I Give and Bequeath to my son James Sedin one pair of Gold Sleeve
Buttons to be bought as aforesaid

I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Sedin one pair of
Gold Sleeve Buttons. to be bought as before. I also Give to my said

Daughter Mary one plain Gold Ring and if my Estate holds out
after my said ^{and last debts} ~~debts~~ ^{are paid} I Give to my said

Daughter Mary Forty pounds Cash to be raised out of my said
Estate. and if any over to be equally divided between my said
three Children Ann. James. and Mary Sedin

My Will and Desire is that my Friend Anthony Holladay of
Harrison County. have the Care of my said Children Ann Sedin
James Sedin and Mary Sedin. and their Estates till they arrive
to lawfull Age or married. I also do nominate and appoint
my abovesaid Friend Anthony Holladay to be my sole Executor
of this my last Will and Testament. In Witnes whereof I have
hereunto set my Hand, and affixed my Seal, this 24th day
of October 1751
