First and -principally, above all Things I commit my Soul to God, the Father of Spirits, hoping and assuredly -believing, to receive full Pardon and Remissions of my Sins through my compassionate Redeemer Jesus Christ, who gave himself to be an -attonement for my Sins, and is able to save all that comes unto God, by him, seeing he liveth to make Intercession for them who comes unto him for Mercy, in this Hope and Confidence. I render up my Soul, with Comfort. Next I Give my Body to the Earth in full Assurance of its Resurrection at the last Day, and for what worldly Estate God in his Mercy hath bestowed upon me, I Give as followeth First. I Desire that all my just Debts should be paid by my Executor hereafter named. - Item. I Give and Bequeath unto my Son Peter Daniel, any two ^{worth} Shillings, out of my moveable Estate and no more. Item. I Give and Bequeath to my Son William Daniel any two ^{worth} Shillings, out of my moveable Estate and no more. Item. I Give and Bequeath to my Son John Daniel two Shillings worth out of my Estate and no more. Item. I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Mary Kate two Shillings worth out of my Estate and no more. Item. I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Barrett two Shillings worth out of my Estate and no more. Item. I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Deberry Lucas two Shillings worth out of my Estate and no more. Item. I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Ann Daniel two Shillings worth out of my

to my Daughter Jarland Daniel, this House and the Lath

no more. I Give and Bequeath to my son James

Increase and no more the Rest of my moveable Estate
I give to my loving Wife, Deborah Daniel till her
Decease and then to her disposing. I appoint my
loving Wife Deborah Daniell my whole Executrix of this
my last Will and Testament to execute and performe
herunto I have set my Hand, and fixed my Seal this
10th Day of September in the Year of our Lord God 1738
