At a Court held for Isle of Wight County the 5th Day of February, 1799. This Will was presented in Court and proved by the oaths of Benjamin Goodrich & Samuel Goodman two of the Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the Motion of William Ward who made oath thereto according to Law, And together with Benjamin Goodrich Security entered into and acknowledged, their bonds in the penalty of Three thousand Dollars with Condition as the Law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining Letters of Administration, with the Will annexed, on the Estate of the said Anne Webb Dead in due form of Law.
