In the name of God Amen I Bartlett Godwin of the County of St.
of Wight and parish of Newport, being of sound mind and memory
thank God for the Same do make and ordain this my last will &
Testament in the following manner — I lend the use of my
Plantation joining Willis Wells unto my mother during her
natural life and at her decease — I turn I lend the same Plantation
unto my Kephew Thomas Flint during his life and if a lawful heir
from his body I give and bequeath unto his heirs forever — & if no such
heirs I give the aforesaid unto my Niece Charlotte Godwin Flint and
her heirs forever — I turn I lend the use of my Negroe boy Aberdeen
at my mothers decease unto Charlotte Godwin Flint until she during
her natural life if a lawful heir from her body or heirs I lend unto
her heirs in the same manner & if no such heir I desire
that the said Aberdeen be liberated as fully and amply as if he had
been born free — I turn I leave the money due me from my Brothers
Estate & all my personal estate after my just debts be paid I give
the balance of the same money to be equally divided between my Kephew
Thomas Flint and my Niece Charlotte Godwin Flint & their heirs forever
