Will

In the name of God Amen I Benjamin Tynes of Isle of Wight County calling to mind
the uncertainty of life make this as my last Will & Testament. In the first place I recommend
my Soul to God, My Body to the Grave, & with regard to my Worldly Goods, I give & bequeath as follows
I give unto my son David the Plantation whereon I now live containing ninety Acres more or less to
him & his Heirs forever. — My Will & desire is that the rest of my Estate be sold & the amount
thereof after paying my just Debts be equally divided between my four Daughters Nancy,
Polly, Temperance, & Sally to them & their Heirs forever. — And whereas there is some expecta-
tion of recovering some property from the Estate of my Uncle Robert Tynes deceased: should any such
property be recovered my Will is that all be divided between my four Daughters above named
& if any of them die before they come of Age I desire such part or parts to be equally divided
amongst the surviving Daughters as I do not mean bequeathing any more to my son David ex-
cept my Land above mentioned thinking that a reasonable proportion for him.
Lastly I appoint my Friend John Brigham whole & sole Executor of this my last Will &
Testament. In Witness whereof I have set my hand & seal this 4th day of June A.D. 1799.

Isle of Wight Co. Wills 1794-1803
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At a Court held for Isle of Wight County the 7th day of October
 1799. This Will was presented in Court by John Elgishart
 the Executor therein named & he was asked the
 evidence to show & the same being proved by the oath of
 William Elgishart & Isaac Woody two of the Witnesses
 thereto & he was admitted to the Office of the
 Executor & he was sworn to perform the duties of the
 Office as such Executor & he was discharged.
