 one feather bed & furniture 6th I Give and bequeath to my Son Jesse Bra
 cey after the death of his mother Ten pounds to be paid in Cash

7th I Give and bequeath to my Son Shadrach Bracey after the death
of his mother five Dollars - 8th I Give all the remainder of my
Estate that I have not before given away to be equally divided between
