Hon Robert Tyner Fulgham the Millbrook plantation, bounded on the north by
John Murray from thence to Wilsons, Brantlys then along Mill Creek up to
Cocks; I then I give, my son Robert T Fulgham all the residue of my estate now
mentioned in my will. - Lastly, I do appoint my son Robert T Fulgham
Executor to this my last will and testament, In witness whereof I have hereunto
Set my hand and Seal this 17th day of October 1806.
