of the testator and the witnesses there and continued for further proof. And at a court
held for the said County the 3th day of February 1799. the said Will was fully proved by
the oath of John Cummins the other witnesses there and ordered to be recorded. And

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according to the record therein named referred to take upon her self the burden of the same
and also on the motion of Samuel Cummins who made oath before me that he was
not the testator William Nelson his security entered into with Acknowledged then
the sum of one thousand dollars with condition as the Law directs and that
he was not the testator.
