 the Cotton that is in my house and the third part of the Crop of Corn
 and Brandy to him and his heirs forever - I Give and bequeath
 unto my Grand Daughter Anneley Saunders one large iron pot and
 large pine chest spinning Wheel and cards, meal tub, water pail, and
 trays, also the remainder part of my Crop of Cotton Corn Brandy that
 is not already given away and one narrow axe also the remainder part
 of my Hogs that is not already given away to her and her heirs forever
 and Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my Son Thomas

Saunders executor of this my Last Will & Testament hereby revo-
king all other former Wills or testaments by me heretofore made
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my
seal this 31st day of Aug^r. in the year of our Lord 1802
