Homan married Serens to her her heirs and assigns forever Item I give
unto my Aunt Mary Appleback nee Brown & furniture to her her heirs & assigns
forever. And lastly I do constitute constitute and ordain my uncle James
Godwin executor to this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hands and affixed my seal this 22nd Day of January one
Thousand eight hundred and one.
