as follows I give to James West Daniel one third of my Estate to him and his heirs
forever, I also I give to Giles West Daniel, Henry Daniel and John Daniel the remain
der part of my Estate to be equally divided Between them to they and their heirs forever
my Will and desire is that my property to be sold for ready cash and I do constitute
and desire that Josiah Wills shall be my Executor to this my last Will and Testament
Given under my hand & Seal this 9th day of January 1800
