Sold at publick Auction in a Credit of twelve months to Satisfy  
my creditors and the residue to remain to my wife Mary Edmonds

my executor and the money arising from the sales, after paying  
my debts and the Expenses that I have all ready given away,  
I give to be equally divided between Elizabeth Edmunds, Phoebe  
Naughton William Edmunds, Anna Edmunds, and Sally  
Edmunds, to them and their heirs for ever.

Lastly I do nominate and appoint my friend Solomon Buller  
to be my whole and sole executor of this my last will and  
Testament Revoking all other Wills before made by me  
Given under my hand and seal this 21<sup>st</sup> day of June 1806
