 and form as followeth, to wit, I Give all my Land that I now possess to be
 equally divided between Joseph James, Peggy & Jane Mitchell except four
 Acres whereon Charlotte Hobbs now lives which I give to her during her natu-
 ral life and after her death I then devise it as above, to wit, I Give my
 Maie to my Brother James Mitchell to him & his heirs, to wit, I also give
 Charlotte Hobbs five Barrells Corn together with what Bacon I have
 by me, also my Soc & piggs, to wit, It is my will and desire that all
 the rest of my Personal Estate be sold and the money arising therefrom
 together with all debts due me to be equally divided between my Bro-
 thers Joseph James, Peggy & Jane Mitchell after all my Just debts
 are paid, I appoint James Gray my whole & Sole executor to my
 last Will & Testament this 28th January 1804

February 1804 This Will was presented into Court by James Gray the
executor therein named who made oath thereto according to Law, & the
Same being proved by the oaths of John Welsh & Easter Cook two of the
witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded - and on the motions of said exor.
who together with Robert R. Broad his Security entered into and
acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars
with conditions as the Law directs Certificate is granted him for obtain-
ing a probat thereof in due form of Law
