JOHN SUGARS

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN:

The last will and testament of John Sugars being in perfect sence and memory thanks be to Almighty God for it this 21 day of December 1726

First I give and bequeth my Soul to Almighty God in hopes of a Glorious resurrection to Eternal Life and my body to be decently born to the grave and buried and for all my worldly goods that God of his mercy hath bestowed upon me I heen dispose of as follows; (vis)

Item I give and bequeth to my daughter Elisabeth Bynas a negro girl called Lucy and amolato boy called Ned the girl she hath already in possession. I give my daughter Elisabeth my negro man Will after my wife decease to be hers and the heirs of her body lawfully begotten forever

Item I give and bequeth to my daughter Abigall Jones amolato Girl called Alte__ and amolato boy called Frank and the increase of the said girl to her and her heirs of her body lawfully begotten forever. I give my daughter Abigall a feather bed and bolster. I give to my daughter Abigall all the land that I have on that side of the branch that Edward Jones now lives upon to her and the heirs of her body lawfully begotten forever.

Item I give and bequeth to my daughter Priscilla my Indian girl Man to her and the heirs of her body lawfully begotten forever only my desire is that my grandson Sugar Jones may have the first child that the said wench brings and that lives to the age of two years and to be kept at the charge of my daughter Priscilla till it comes to the age of two years.

I give my daughter Priscilla my negro boy Peter and amplate girl Sarah to her and the heirs of her body lawfully begotten for ever and the increase of the said

girl. I give to my daughter Priscilla a feather bed and bolster rug & blanket. I give to my daughter Priscilla the plantation whereon I now live and all of my land that I have belonging to the same plantation to her and the heirs of her body lawfully begotten forever after my wives decease all going of the plantation my desire is that my wife Elisa Suare may have the laboure of my Indian wench Nan as long as she lives or abides on my plantation where I now live and

Item I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elisa Sugars all the rest of my whole estate whatsoever during her natural life and after her decease if anything remain to be divided equally between my three daughters and I do appoint my wife my whole and sole Executrix of this my last will and testament: And I appoint John Persons, my oversear to see it fully performed.
