In the name of God amen I John Vellines of Ingham County
Being sick in body and of sound mind and memory do make this for my last will
and testament in manner and form following and I do constitute the same (viz) —
I Item I give unto my son Joseph Vellines half the plantation I now live on that part
that the houses stands on also two Negroes Tom and Charlotte to him and his heirs forever —
I Item I give unto Isaac Vellines the other half of my plantation also I give two negroes
Jacob and Luce to him and his heirs forever — I Item I give unto my Loving wife
Olive Vellines three negroes Mack Venus and Lurus during her widow hood also
two feather beds and two Cases and Calves to her disposal. — I Item I give unto
my daughter Nancy Vellines Two Negroes Ben and Isaac to her and her heirs forever —
I Item I give unto my daughter Rebekah Vellines two Negroes Selvy and Chary to
her and her heirs forever. — I Item I give unto my daughter Sally Vellines two
Negroes Aron and Agge to her and her heirs forever. — And the ballance of my estate
that I has not given away to be sold and equally Divided amongst my surviving
Children, I do hereby constitute and appoint my brother Isaac Vellines my
whole and sole Executor to this my last will and testament. Given under my
hand this twenty second day of April eight hundred and seven. —
