to wit Francis, Josiah, John and George and their heirs forever — I do hereby
revoke and annul all former Wills and Testaments by me made or to be made

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Grandson, Whetogany, Sable one still worn & cap, Negroes Peter, Jerry and
youngest child, Esther, Mary and their increase and all, also five hundred
pounds cash to him and his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto

my Daughter Patsy Warren one side saddle, Negroes, Sam, Amangia, Sally,
Violet Charlotte and bob and their increase, also five hundred pounds cash
to her and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Patsy

Warren, Negroes Mary and two children (say) Charlotte and Dick, Patience Isaac
and Henry and their increase, also five hundred pounds cash to her and her heirs
forever. Item It is my will and desire that

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the property that he is now in possession of to him and his heirs forever.

It is also my Will and desire that the ^{residue} ~~unresidue~~ of my Estate to be equally
divided between all my children Sarah Francis, Josiah Patsy and Betsey.
