Wright & State of Virginia being very sick but in perfect mind and
memory, thanks be given unto God, calling unto mind the mortality of
my body, and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die do make
and ordain this my last will and testament that is to say principally
and first of all, I give and recommend my soul into the hands of
Almighty God that gave it, and my body I recommend to the earth to
be buried in decent Christian burial, at the discretion of my Executor nothing
doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again
by the mighty power of God and as touching such worldly estate wherewith
it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give dismiss, and dispose of the same
in the following manner and form — Item I give and bequeath to
my son Joshua Turner one Colt and one bow to him and his heirs forever
Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Amicia one dish and feather
bed to her and her heirs forever — Item I give and bequeath to my
Martha one negro woman named Hannah and one feather bed to her
and her heirs forever — Item I give and bequeath to my daughter
Elizabeth one dish and feather bed to her and her heirs forever —

and her heirs forever — Item I Give and bequeath to my daughter
Elizabeth one bed and one Tuffer to her and her heirs forever —

Item I Give to my son John Turner the sum of six shillings to be paid
out of the ballance of my estate to him and his heirs forever —

Item I give to my daughter Mary Woodward the sum of six shillings
to be paid out of the balance of my estate to her and her heirs forever —

Then my wish is that the ballance of my household and furniture should
be equally divided between my three Daughters Annⁿ Martha and
Elizabeth to them and their heirs forever — And I do hereby utterly disallow revoke

and disannul all and every other former testaments, wills, legacies & last

wills by me in any wise before made, made and bequeathed relating and confir-

ming this to be my last will and testament; In W^{it}ness whereof I have
