Heirs for ever. Item 2^d This my Will and Desire that my two
Sons, Jordan and Harrison Houbwell be bound out to learn the
Cabinet Trade at the End of this Year. Item 3^d This my Will
and Desire that my Son Joel Houbwell be School master after
the end of this Year out to a good Teacher Item 4th This my Will
and Desire that my Daughter Lucy Houbwell be School Teacher
Item 5th This my Will and Desire that my Daughter Mary

I have made this my last Will and Testament in full knowledge and perfect memory of mind and I desire that the
business should enjoy the other Part. Item &c It is my Will and
Desire that my Friend Henry Gray and John Gwallney be my Executors
to this my last Will and Testament, without revoking and annulling
