In the name of God Amen I Nathan Whitley of the
Parish of Newport and County of Isle of Wight Being in perfect
health and sound memory but calling to mind that there is an ap-
pointed time and that all men must once die I do make ordain and
constitute this my last Will and Testament in manner following
to wit I Give and bequeath after my Decease to my Son Jesse
Whitley the ~~incomer~~ Plantation whereon I now live to him and his
heirs forever I Give ~~to my Son Jesse~~ ^{Isle of Wight Co Will 4794-1803} to my Son Elias Whitley all
the remainder of my Land lying over Black Water Road to him and
his heirs forever I Give and Bequeath all the Remainder of my
Estate to be equally Divided amongst all my children after my
Decease to them and their Heirs for ever and I do appoint Jesse
Whitley Executor of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness
