 make and ordain this to be my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following.
 I give to my daughter Jane Dimes Gray all my Lands and Negroes with all
 my other Estate after my just Debts and Funerals expenses are paid to her or her heirs but
 should she die without her in that event I give all my Estate to be equally divided between all
 my Brothers and Sisters then living or their heirs or assigns. I appoint my Brother
 Josiah Gray executor of this my Last Will and Testament.

At a Court held for Isle of Wight County the 2^d day of September 1799. This Will was presented in Court by Josiah Gray the Executor therein named who made oath thereunto according to Law and the same being proved by the Oaths of Ephraim Wheeler & William Pitts two of the witnesses thereto as aforesaid and ordered to be recorded. And on the Motion of the said Executor who together with Thomas King his Security entered into & Acknowledged their bond in the penalty of twenty thousand Dollars with the condition as the Law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form.
