Will

In the name of Almighty God I Nicholas Tomlin of  
Isle of Wight County being weak and feeble in body but of sound and perfect  
memory at present calling to remembrance this transitory state of life do hereby make  
known and constitute this to be my last Will and testament in manner and form  
following (Wife) — I Give unto my wife Rebecca Tomlin the use of my  
plantation, houses and household furniture of every kind during her natural life  
or widowhood except what I shall particular name, after giving her what I  
shall name. — I also give to my wife as above mentioned one barrel horse, five  
heads of cattle, her choice of my stock also three heads of sheep, her choice also of  
all my boys except one cow and pigs. — I also will and desire my brothers  
Matthew Tomlin and John Tomlin to examine the residue of my estate and sell  
what they may think proper to make sale of and to put the said Money the use of  
maintaining and schooling my children as they may see cause to do except one year I  
give to my son Joseph Tomlin. I Give and bequeath unto my son Joseph  
Tomlin my remaining plantation that I now dwell on and land all that lies on the  
North side of the new line that I made in presence of Matthew Tomlin, John Tomlin  
and Humphrey Beckett, to him and his heirs forever. — I Give and bequeath  
unto my son Lewis Tomlin the other part of my land lying on the South side

what they may think proper to make sale of and to put the said money the use of  
maintaining and schooling my children as they may see cause to do. except one year I  
give to my son Joseph Toulon. Item I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph  
Toulon my insurance plantation that I now dwell on and land all that lies on the  
North side of the new line that I made in presence of Matthew Toulon, John Toulon  
and Humphrey Powell, to him and his heirs forever. — Item I give and bequeath  
unto my son Lewis Toulon the other part of my land lying over on the South side  
of the new line on the Mill pond, called the old place, to him and his heirs forever

I also will and desire that all the ~~estate or inheritance~~ of my wife that what of my  
said estate may concern with her, or be sold in legally divided amongst my  
said nearest heirs Toulon, Matthew Toulon & Lewis Toulon, fairly and justly

without and without of any one should see before they come to be put  
in without force that that the purpose of her that she may have the place  
of her estate that she may have the same as she may see fit

in my will and desire that all the estate or inheritance of my wife that what of my

At a Court held for Isle of Wight County the 5th day of June 1797

The last Will and Testament of Nicholas Tomlin was presented in Court by Matthew Tomlin one of the Executors therein named who made Oath thereto according to law and the same being proved by the Oath of Humphrey Reast, and the affirmation of Joseph Westagy the Witnesses thereto and desired to be recorded. And in the witness of the said Executor who together with Joseph Westagy his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars with condition as the law directs Certificate is granted here for obtaining a probate thereof in due form
