frank and County of Isle of Wight in Virginia being now sick and weak in body  
and in my perfect senses and memory I thank God for the same do think proper  
to make and Ordain this to be my Last Will and Testament in manner an

form following. I desire that my Executors be *John Young* and *John*

and I am bequeathed during the term of four years and the money arising  
therefrom together with the Bond and Interest due me from John Young  
I am after my decease to be paid to my Executors *John Young* and *John*  
that to be paid may be applied to my children *John* and *John*

and I am bequeathed the children and the inheritance of my children  
I am after my decease to be paid to my Executors *John Young* and *John*  
that to be paid may be applied to my children *John* and *John*

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Tom be immediately set free. Item my Will and Desire is that after my  
Decease my Negro Woman by Name Rachel, be libertized and set free.  
Lastly I appoint George Benn and Bennett Young Executors of this my  
last Will and Testament, in evidence whereof I have hereunto set my  
hand and Affixed my Seal this 13<sup>th</sup> Day of November 1798.
