Will

In the name of God almighty I, Richard Chapman of Isle of Wight County calling to remembrance that all have to die do at this time make order and Constetute this my last will and Testament in manner and form following - Item I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Polly Chapman five Negroes Namely Well old Moses old Holland young Holland old Kate during her natural life one bed and furniture and Kitchen furniture one dining Chair and horse and half a dozen flaged Chairs at my Present dwelling house one painted pine Chest of a Mahogany colour to her as above mentioned - Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Nancy Chapman twelve Negroes Namely Lucy Lovina Tempy Violet Chastot Tomb Jordan Samm Chaney old Jimmy pleasant many to her and her lawful heirs begotten of her body if none at her decease to return to my son Henah H. Chapman or to my family Connection &c. Item I give and bequeath unto my son Henah H. Chapman Eleven Negroes namly Lewis fillips young Moses Jimmy Nasser hammer wany Mowah Willis Siller to him and his heirs Lawfully begotten of his body if none at his decease to return to my daughter Nancy or my family Connection as above mentioned to wash and other of the poor - Item I also will and devise at the decease

to each and either of them forever — I then I also will and desire at the death  
of my wife that the above Negroes given to her and their increase shall return  
with their increase to my daughter and son above mentioned to be equally divided  
I then I give and bequeath to my son Henrich H. Chapman one new Desk  
to him and his lawful heirs for Ever — I then I also give and bequeath unto  
my daughter Nancy Chapman one Bophat and old Desk also my upper plantations  
as aforesaid — I then I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Polly Chapman  
two Cows and Calves the first Choice of my Stock, two Cows and lambs of the first  
choice, one Sow and Piggys of the first choice of my Stock — I then I will and  
Desire all my Estate remaining, not given away, to be equally and fairly to be  
divided between my daughter Nancy Chapman and Henrich H. Chapman after all my  
Just debts are paid — I then I also will and desire that Joseph Westray, do be my  
sole and sole executor to this my last will and testament revoking all other wills  
in writing made by me at any time, To which I Set my hand and affix my Seal  
this seven and twentieth day of January one Thousand Eight hundred and Seven

in perfect Health, with a perfect sound mind and memory, but knowing it is appointed  
unto all woman once to Die, do make constitute and ordain this my last Will and testament  
in manner and form ~~as~~ followeth (Wit)

I Give and bequeath unto my Son Peter Turner the whole of my Estate after  
paying all my just Debts and funeral Expenses, to him his heirs and assigns forever;  
And I do also hereby, Appoint my Son Peter Turner, Whole and Sole Executor of this my  
last will and Testament. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
Seal this 21<sup>th</sup> day of May 1808
