This Instrument of writing I leave as my last Will and Testament, that is my
desire that my Estate go in the following manner to wit, — I give unto my
Daughter Lucy Blaw, then heir a Negro boy by the name of Lirner —
I give unto my wife all the balance of my Estate her life to do as she thinks proper
at the death of my wife if she thinks proper she may give my Daughter Lucy
Blaw and her heirs & my son Richard Taylor any part of my Estate she thinks
proper the balance of my Estate at the death of my wife I wish to be equally
divided between my Daughter Mildred D. Williams and my Daughter Mary Truitt
Taylor if my Daughter Mildred should die or Mary her part of the Estate after
death I wish to be equally divided between her two children Maria A. Williams
& Lucy G. Williams if the children Maria A. Williams & Lucy G. Williams
should die their their part of the Estate to return to my Wife to do with as she
thinks proper. I appoint my wife and William H. Jeger my Executors to collect
I have hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this 3rd day September 1881 —
