declare this to be my last Will & Testament in manner & form following

Reynolds one Negroe Woman (Violet) to she and her heirs forever.

I also give to her the said Aunt Martha Reynolds one Negroe Girl Anne
to she and her heirs forever. — 2^d I give to Sabra Chapman Reynolds Daugh-
