being of perfect & sound mind & memory do make & ordain this my Last Will & Testament in manner and form as followeth (Viz) — I Item I give & bequeath unto

my son in Law & my Daughter William & Martha Turner five Shillings sterling
to them & their heirs for ever, I Item I give unto my son John Edwards one half to

him & his heirs for ever, I Item I lend to my beloved wife Martha Edwards all the

Remainder of my Estate of every nature & kind during her widowhood, & if she
does not marry during her life I do ordain that after her Decease it is my desire that all

my Estate then remaining should be Equally Divided between my surviving Child
children except William & Martha Turners & I do hereby appoint Martha Edwards

& my son Robert Edwards Executors to this my Last Will & Testament given under
my hand & Seal this 11th day of February 1795
