Will

This Instrument of Writing I leave as my last Will and Testament, &c
it is my desire that all my Estate may go in the following Manner to
Wit. I give and devise unto my Daughter Emily Baker Wilson, all
my Houses and Lotts in the Town of Smithfield. I give unto George
Wilson my Plantation in Isle of Wight. I give unto my son James
Reddick Wilson all my Lands in Adams and County. My Lotts
in Norfolk I leave to be equally divided between my son George
Wilson and James R. Wilson. My Lands in the County of Green
brier and all the residue of my property I leave to be equally Divi
ded Between my Daughter Emily B. Wilson George Wilson, and
James R. Wilson. I appoint William Partrick, Robert Farmer, &
John Goodrich to be my Executors, and it is my wish and desire
that William Partrick may be Guardian to my Daughter Emily B.
Wilson, Robert Farmer, Guardian to my son George Wilson, and
John Goodrich, Guardian to my son James R. Wilson. To which
