manner and form following —

I premise Here I Give and bequeath to my Grandson —  
Jesse Atkins fifty Acres of land whereon I now live beginning  
at first Swamp at the mouth of a branch leading up towards  
the house thence a straight line to Sarah Atkins line to him and  
~~his heirs forever~~ it is my will and desire that Martha Atkins  
should have the use of five acres of land around her house where  
she now lives during her single life also it is my will and desire  
that my daughter Cloe Atkins shall have her single life  
whereon I now live — I now I Give and bequeath  
unto my Grandson Jesse Atkins the remainder part of

unto my grandson Moses Atkins the remainder part of  
my lands, only Selah Atkins is to have her single life out  
of Elizabeth Atkins is to have the use of three acres  
around the house during her single life, to him and his heirs  
forever. Lastly I do nominate constitute and appoint  
Moses Atkins Exor. of this my last will and Testament  
and In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
I affixed my seal this 29<sup>th</sup> Day of March In the  
year of our love 1808 -

proved by the oaths of Ishmael Moody, Wilson Moody  
J. Willis Womble the witnesses thereto, and is ordered to be Recorded  
On the motion of the said Exec. who together with  
Ishmael Moody his security entered into and acknowledged their  
bond in the penalty of 100 dollars with condition as the  
law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining  
Probate thereof in due form
