to be my last will and testament in manner & form following —

heirs forever — one feather Bed and furniture, the money that Zacha-
riah Womble owes me for the portion that is due by the sale of a
negro Frank. together with all my other estate of every kind
whatsoever —

Item 2nd I Nominate and Appoint my friend Thomas Pitman
my executor to this my last Will and Testament, utterly revoking
all other Wills hereby made. In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal this second day of
May in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and Six —
