William Hollowell of the County of Isle of Wight & State of Virginia, being weak and
lacking of body, the of a sound mind & memory do so fit to make and ordain this to be my
last will & testament in manner & form following First I Give & bequeath unto
my sister Courtney Hollowell, my sister Mary Hollowell, & my brother Thomas Hollowell
all the Land & plantation whereon Scott Hollowell formerly lived who gave the
same in his last will and Testament to me; that is to say I Give the said Land
to be equally divided between my above mentioned two sisters Courtney & Mary
and my brother Thomas Hollowell, to them their heirs & assigns forever,
Secondly I Give the use of a Negro boy named Ephraim to my sister Courtney
Hollowell untill he shall arrive to the age of twenty one years Thirdly I Give the
use of a negro Girl named Luceary to my sister Mary Hollowell untill she shall
become eighteen years of age Fourthly I Give unto the above mentioned two Negroes
to wit, Ephraim and Luceary five Pounds of Law full money to each of them
paid by my Executors out of my Estate as soon as they shall arrive to the ages
above mentioned, Fifthly I Give & bequeath unto my Sister Courtney Hollowell
Mary Hollowell, & Thomas Hollowell all the rest & residue of my Estate to be equ-
ally divided between them after paying my Just debts & funeral expences Lastly I do
hereby nominate and appoint James Barlow Senr. Courtney Hollowell and
Mary Hollowell, my whole & sole executor & Executors of this my last will &
Testament I in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal

This will was presented in to court by James Barlow one of the executors therein named
whom made oath thereto according to Law, and the same being proved by the oaths
of Robert Glover & Thomas Brantley two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be
Recorded and on the motion of said Executor who together with Thomas Gibbs &
Robert Gibbs his securities entered into and acknowledged the Bond in the penalty
of one thousand Dollars with condition that the said Executor should pay to the said
Thomas Gibbs the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars
