

Wm Moody's Will - 3 In the name of God Amen I William Moody of the County of Isle of Wight do think proper to make and constitute this my last Will & Testament in manner and form following calling to mind this transitory life, being yet uncertain & full weakness but at present of sound memory thanks be to god for the same I am I will and desire that my wife Fanny Moody may have the use of Plantation during her natural life also one Negre woman named Fannas during her natural life, and after the decease of my wife that my Land be legally and firmly divided between my two Children namely Betty & Philip Moody also the residue of my estate after my just debts being fairly settled that the remains of my Estate be fairly and Legally divided amongst my wife and two Children as above named to which set my hand and affix my seal this 4th day of December 1800 - Desiring that my friend Burwell Harris with my wife do have the care of my estate and settle the same agreeable to my directions above mentioned
