memory and being to mind the uncertain state of this transitory Life do make and ordain
and Declare this to be my Last Will and Testament as followeth (to wit)

I Desire all my just Debts to be paid
I Give and Bequeath unto my son John George Woodward all my Lands and Tenements being
the same that I have already made him a deed of gift for and which is Recorded on the Court of
Isle of Wight County to him and his heirs for ever also one Bed, Bedstead and furniture one small

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gun now in his possession and one silver plate is Likewise in his possession I
Give and Bequeath to my son William Hall Woodward the following Negroes to wit My wife
woman Judith Lundy Gachabach one Mares and three horses my saddle horse Bunch
and saddle one bed and furniture and my old gun to him and his heirs for ever to it

observed that these request Excepting what are all given to my son William Hall Woodward
as a deed of gift and Recorded in the County Court of Isle of Wight State I Give and Bequeath
My Daughter Sally Woodward one Bedstead and furniture all my Glass lantern
and some some one silver plate now in her possession and one Blue cloth to her and
her heirs for ever I Give and Bequeath to my son John George Woodward all my Lands and
and contents of my estate my Debts and Bequeath to my son William

the same that I have already made him a deed of gift and which is Recorded on the Court of
Soloflight County to him and his heirs for ever also one Bed, Bedstead and furniture one small
gun now in his possession as also a Large Looking Glass is likewise in his possession then I
give and bequeath to my son William Hall Woodward the following Negroes, namely My wife
woman Judith Lundy Zashabash and Meston and there increase my said horse Brule
and saddle one bed, bedstead and furniture and my old gun to him and his heirs for ever to it
observed that these negroes excepting Meston are all given to my son William Hall Woodward
in a deed of gift and Recorded in the County Court of Soloflight North Carolina and written
My daughter ~~Elizabeth~~ ^{Elizabeth} Woodward and her husband and furniture all my glass looking
and stone ware one side saddle now in her possession and one Blue shirt to her and
her heirs for ever then the remainder or Residue of my Estate of what ever Nature
and kind of after paying my Debts I give and bequeath to my son William
Hall Woodward and to his heirs forever and I hereby certify that my said son
William and William H. Woodward are the only persons who are in this case of

therein and I have been in the County of Stafford
with Andrew Rice and Henry Cripps for some years and
I have in the County of Stafford been a free man and the

mind and memory hereby be to the Almighty for the same I do make and ordain
this to be my last will and testament in manner and form as follows I do leave
the use of one half of the Land and plantation that I now live on that is all the
Land that I bought of Andrew Giffen and James Carter that is the Land
I include the plantation I say one half of it with my Dwelling houses and one
half of my Apple Orchard and one half of my Tyder Mill to my loving wife
Ann Duck her life and after her Death I give the same with the Remainder
of the Land above mentioned to my son Joseph Duck to him and his heirs
for ever that the other half of this Land that I have left to my wife I give
it to my son Joseph Duck to him and his heirs and I give to my son Joseph Duck

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
